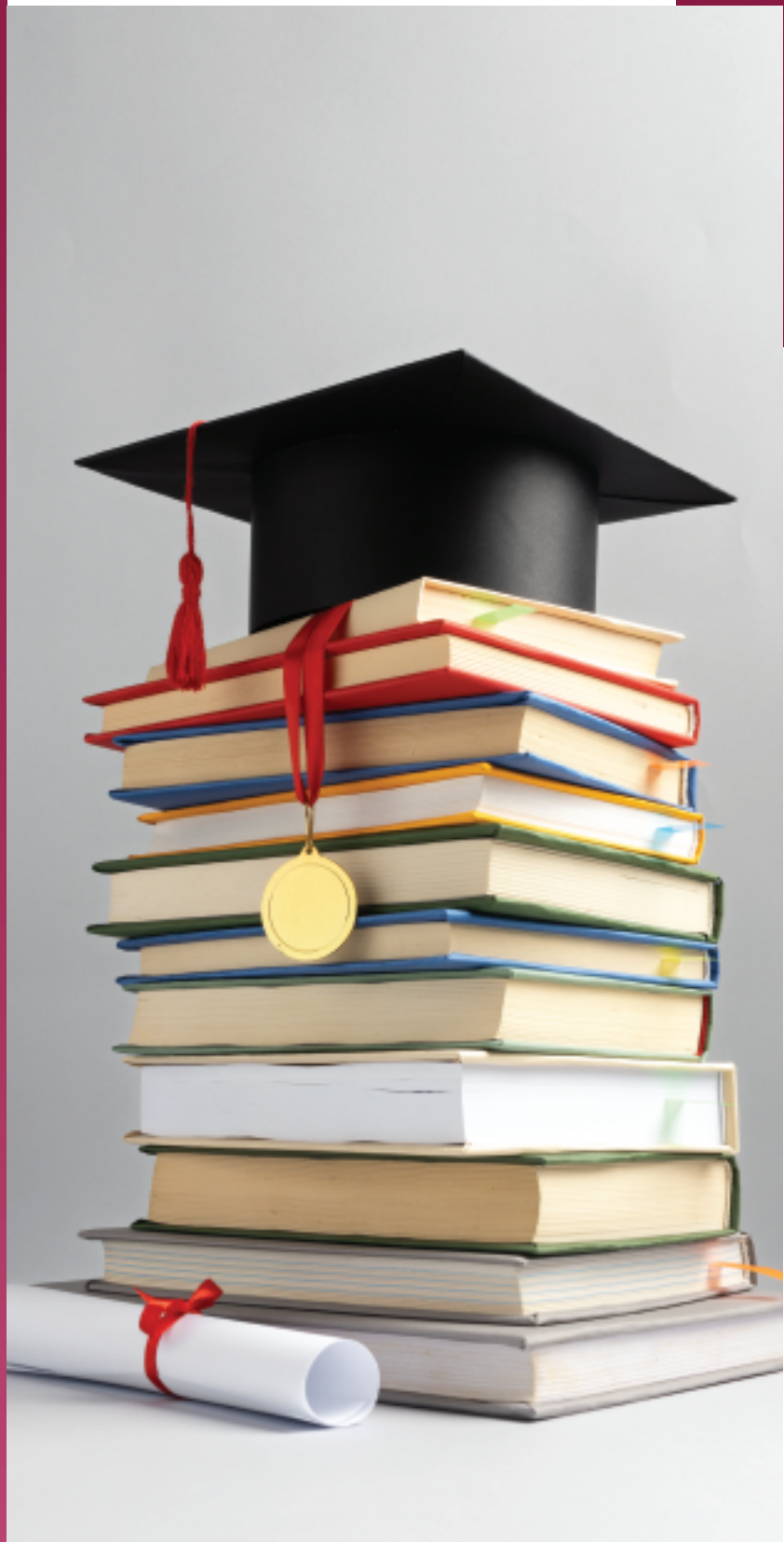

WORLD'S BIGGEST ELECTRIC CRUISE SHIP

The largest electric cruise ship in the world has returned back to port in Yichang in central Hubei province, China after traveling up and down the Yangtze River for its maiden voyage.

OVERVIEW:

- This cruise ship has been powered by a 7,500-kilowatt-hour massive-sized marine battery.
- This battery has been provided by Contemporary Amperex Technology, the No. 1 battery manufacturer for electric cars in the world. From the month of April 2022 this ship will be beginning commercial operations.
- This ship will mainly be used for the purpose of conducting sightseeing trips. The developer of this ship, China Yangtze Power has plans to use this electric ship as the starting point for expanding the marine electric vehicle market in China.

ABOUT THE SHIP

The name of the ship is Yangtze River Three Gorges 1 and it is a 100 percent electric cruise ship that has been developed and built in China. Its main purpose will be to ferry passengers who will be going on sightseeing trips on the River Yangtze. This ship has been developed by China Yangtze Power which is China Three Gorges Corp's subsidiary, and Hubei Three Gorges Tourism Group and costs 150 million yuan or USD \$23.66 million.



HURUN RICHEST SELF-MADE WOMEN IN THE WORLD 2022

Three Indian women Kiran Mazumdar-Shaw of Biocon, Falguni Nayar of Nykaa, and Radha Vembu of Zoho have been featured in the latest Hurun Richest Self-Made Women in the World 2022 (Hurun list of women self-made billionaires). According to this list, currently, in the world, there are 124 self-made women billionaires

WHO HAS TOPPED THIS LIST?

Wu Yajun, a Beijing-based property developer has topped this list. Her estimated worth is USD 17 billion. She cofounded Longfor in 1993 with her ex-husband Cai Kui. In 2021, Longfor reported revenues of USD 34.6 billion.

INDIANS ON THIS LIST

- CEO and Founder of Nykaa, **Falguni Nayar** with 7.6 billion dollars has been placed in the top 10 richest list. She overtook billionaire Kiran Mazumdar-Shaw to become India's richest self-made woman. She was also featured in first place in Hurun's list of Top 10 New Faces.
- Among the biggest risers, **Radha Vembu** is first in India, and second across the world. Vembu is India's second-richest self-made woman billionaire with USD 3.9bn. Vembu is Zoho's product manager, a company she founded along with her brother. On the Hurun list, she has been placed on the 25th rank.
- **Kiran Mazumdar-Shaw**, founder and executive chairperson of Biocon Biologics and Biocon Limited, has been placed 26th on the list with a wealth of USD 3.8 bn. From last year she dropped down two places.

PUBLIC EMERGENCY IN SRI LANKA

Sri Lanka's president Gotabaya Rajapaksa has declared a state of emergency in the country which gives sweeping powers to the country's security forces. This was declared after hundreds of citizens of the country tried to storm his house seething with anger over the economic crisis Sri Lanka is facing.

OVERVIEW:

The tough laws that were invoked give powers to the military to detain and arrest any suspect without trial for long periods of time. The citizens of the country are protesting and calling for his resignation as the country is in turmoil. The nation is facing severe essential shortages, rise in prices, crippling power cuts, etc. In the country, a night-time curfew has been imposed following continuous protests against the President of the country.

WHY WAS THE EMERGENCY DECLARED?

The emergency has been declared so that public order in the country can be maintained as well as the protection of services and supplies that are essential to the community.



THE ECONOMIC CONDITION OF THE COUNTRY

Inflation in the country has hit 18.7 percent. Food prices have soared by 30.1 percent. Diesel shortages have also sparked outrage across the country. Daily 13-hours of a power cut is being imposed as there is no diesel for running the generators. The state-run hospitals of the country are also facing shortages of life-saving medicines. The International Monetary Fund has been approached by the government while more loans have been asked for from India and China.

REASONS FOR THE ECONOMIC WORSENING OF THE COUNTRY

Sri Lanka's economic condition has taken a hit due to the Covid-19 pandemic, due to which the tourism industry, the country's major source of income, has suffered a lot. Many economists believe that the crisis has increased due to mismanagement of the government and accumulation of borrowings.

MERGER OF HDFC LIMITED AND HDFC BANK

HDFC's board of directors has approved the merger of HDFC Bank, India's largest private sector bank with HDFC (Housing Development Finance Corporation), India's largest housing finance firm.

OVERVIEW:

- The deal will be building the housing loan portfolio of the bank and will also be enhancing its existing customer base.
- Under the agreement that has been proposed, public shareholders will be 100 percent owning HDFC Bank, and HDFC Limited's existing shareholders will own 41 percent stake in HDFC Bank. As per the share exchange ratio, for every 25 equity shares that are held by the shareholders of HDFC, they will be receiving 42 equity

shares of the combined company.

- After the announcement of the agreement, HDFC Bank shares rose by 14 percent, and the share price of HDFC rose by more than 16 percent on BSE Sensex and NSE Nifty.

WHY WAS THIS AGREEMENT DONE?

The proposed agreement will be creating a large net worth as well as a balance sheet that would allow a greater credit flow into the economy. Also, underwriting of larger ticket loans such as infrastructure loans will be enabled due to this agreement.

ABOUT THE MERGER

This will be a two-part merger. In the first

step, HDFC Holdings Limited and HDFC Investments Limited will be merging with HDFC Limited. In the next step, HDFC Limited will be amalgamated with HDFC Bank. After merging, the total assets of HDFC Bank and HDFC Ltd will be more than Rs 25 lakh crore. The turnover of HDFC is Rs 35,681.74 crore while for HDFC Bank it is Rs 1.16 lakh crore.

CONCLUSION

The deal will be completed in 18 months after getting approval from the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), the Competition Commission of India, the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI), and the National Housing Bank.



NASA'S SPACEX CREW-4 MISSION

SpaceX and NASA are gearing up to launch astronauts to the International Space Station (ISS) as part of the Commercial Crew Program of NASA. This will be the fourth crew rotation mission and will be carrying an international crew consisting of four astronauts on a science expedition to the ISS.

OVERVIEW

- This mission will be launched on 20th April from NASA's Kennedy Space Center's Launch Complex 39A. The Kennedy Space Center is located in Florida.
- The crew that will be sent aboard the ISS will be spending several month conducting various maintenance and science aboard the orbiting space station. The astronauts will be returning to Earth in the fall of 2022.
- The crew will be riding on a new Crew Dragon spacecraft and will be launched on a Falcon 9 booster. As a tradition of naming a new capsule by the first riding astronauts, the crew chose the name "Freedom" to celebrate the fundamental human right.
- After docking at the space station, the

- Crew-4 astronauts will be welcomed by Expedition 67's seven-member crew.
- Several days after Crew-4's arrival the astronauts of the Crew-3 mission will be undocking from the ISS and will splash down off Florida's coast.
 - The commander of the Crew-4 mission and the Crew Dragon spacecraft is Lindgren.

EXPERIMENTS THAT WILL BE CONDUCTED BY CREW-4 ASTRONAUTS

New scientific research will be conducted by the Crew-4 astronauts in the areas of health technologies, materials science, and plant science with the aim of preparing for human exploration beyond the low-Earth orbit and to benefit life on Earth. The experiments will be including studies on the immune systems aging, cardiorespiratory effects that are felt during and after long-duration exposure to microgravity, and organic material concrete alternatives.

INDIAN WINNERS AT THE GRAMMY AWARDS 2022

At the 64th Annual Grammy Awards, two Indian musicians were among the winners. Falu, an Indian-American singer-songwriter won her maiden Grammy in the category of Best Children's Music Album. Composer Ricky Kej also won his second Grammy as he and Stewart Copeland won the award in the category of Best New Age Album.

ABOUT FALU

Falguni Shah or Falu won the award for her album *A Colorful World* in the category of Best Children's Music Album. Falu is a New York-based musician and has collaborated with AR Rahman for the movie *Slumdog Millionaire*. In Mumbai, under the legendary vocal master and sarangi Ustad Sultan Khan, she had received her early music training. She also performed in the opening number of the GRAMMY Premiere Ceremony and later won her award.

ABOUT RICKY KEJ

In 2015, Ricky Kej had won his first Grammy Award and this win was his second. He won the award with Stewart Copeland for the album *Divine Tides*. He won the award in the Best New Age Album category.

ABOUT 2022 GRAMMY AWARDS

The 2022 Grammy Awards were held on 3rd March at the MGM Grand Garden Arena located in Las Vegas, Nevada. Trevor Noah hosted this event. Jon Batiste won the Best Album of The Year award. The award for the Best New Artist as well as for Best Pop Vocal Album was won by Olivia Rodrigo and Doja Cat won the award for Best Pop Duo/ Group.

SUSPENSION OF RUSSIA FROM UNHRC

ABOUT UNHRC

The UNHRC is an inter-governmental body under the United Nations. It is responsible for the protection and promotion of human rights across the world. The UNHRC also investigates human rights breaches and addresses various human rights issues. On 15th March 2006, this council was established by the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA). The UNHRC replaced the earlier formed United Nations Commission on Human Rights. There are 47-member states in the UNHRC and they serve for three years. They cannot be re-elected immediately after serving two consecutive terms. Federico Villegas is the current president of the UNHRC.

THE PROCESS OF REMOVAL OF A COUNTRY

The UNGA can suspend any Council member that committed human rights violation during its membership term. A two-thirds majority vote is required by the General Assembly to suspend a member.

SUSPENSION OF RUSSIA

The United States first moved the resolution to suspend Russia over its military aggression in Ukraine. The resolution to remove Russia was titled 'Suspension of the rights of membership of the Russian Federation in the Human Rights Council'. Under this resolution, grave concerns regarding human rights abuses committed by Russia in Ukraine were highlighted. The campaign to suspend Russia started after photos and videos of civilians killed by the Russian army in Bucha came to the fore.

NITI AAYOG'S STATE ENERGY AND CLIMATE INDEX

The State Energy and Climate Index (SECI) has been launched by NITI Aayog. It is a first of- its- kind index that aims to track the efforts made in the energy and climate sector by the states and UTs of India. This index's parameters have been devised while keeping in mind the country's goals regarding clean energy transition and climate change.

OVERVIEW:

- This index has ranked the states and the UTs of India based on the efforts they have put towards improving energy consumption, energy access, safeguarding the environment, and energy efficiency.
- This index has also helped to move toward the agenda of the accessible, affordable, clean, and efficient energy transition at the State level.
- This index has also encouraged healthy competition among the states and UTs of the nation in different fields of climate and energy.

PARAMETERS OF THE INDEX

- Six parameters have been used by this index that are:
- Access Affordability and Reliability of Energy
- Discoms' (Power distribution companies) Performance
- Energy Efficiency
- Clean Energy Initiatives
- New Initiatives
- Environmental Sustainability

These parameters have been further divided into 27 indicators. Based on SECI Round I's composite score the states and UTs of the country have been ranked as smaller states, larger states, and UTs, based on geographical differences and size. The States and the UTs have been categorized into three groups i.e. Achievers, Front

Runners, and Aspirants.

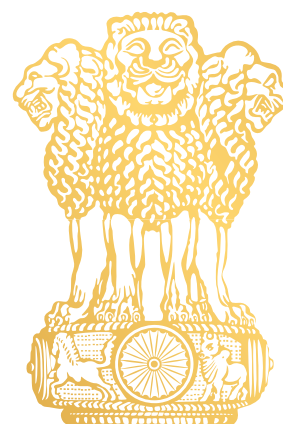

103 YEARS OF JALLIANWALA BAGH MASSACRE

103 years ago, on 13th April 1919, the horrific Jallianwala Bagh Massacre took place. To date, it is one of the country's darkest days in history. On this day, General Reginald Dyer of the British Empire ordered his troops to fire upon the people who were protesting peacefully at Jallianwala Bagh. The firing by the troops killed around 379 people and the entire nation was shocked due to this incident.

BACKGROUND:

Thousands of people had gathered at Jallianwala Bagh to celebrate Baisakhi and to protest peacefully against the arrest of two leaders, Saifuddin Kitchlew, and Satyapal. But at that time processions and public meetings were banned in India and the villagers were unaware of it. Dyer entered the venue with his troops and blocked the only entrance. Then he passed the order of shooting at the unarmed civilians. After the incident, Dyer stated that his act was not to disperse the meeting but to punish the Indians who were present at the venue for disobedience. According to the official figures provided by the British

government, 379 people were killed with thousands severely injured. But, as per the Congress, more than 1,000 Indians lost their lives that day.

THE AFTERMATH OF THE INCIDENT

Mahatma Gandhi and Rabindranath Tagore condemned this unjust attack on the peaceful protestors and renounced their Kaiser-i-Hind medal and British Knighthood respectively. There were protests across the country against the incident. The actions of Dyer were criticized by many including former British Prime Minister Winston Churchill. After this incident, the Hunter commission was set up to investigate the incident, and Dyer was removed from duty after the commission submitted its report. Dyer passed away on 23rd July 1927 due to a cerebral haemorrhage. This incident is referred to by some historians as the beginning of the end of British rule in India. Till now Britain has never formally apologised for the massacre but in 2019 they expressed "deep regret."



TREE CITY OF THE WORLD' TAG

The United Nations Food and Agriculture Organisation (UN-FAO) along with Arbor Day Foundation has recognized Hyderabad and Mumbai jointly as the '2021 Tree City of the World.'

OVERVIEW:

- The programme was started by the UN-FAO and Arbor Day Foundation, an American nonprofit organisation. The aim of starting this programme was to recognise towns and cities across the world that are committed to ensuring that their trees and urban forests are sustainably managed, properly maintained, and duly celebrated.
- Under this programme assistance, direction, and worldwide recognition is provided to those communities that are showing dedication to their urban forest. The programme also provides a framework for a sustainable and healthy urban forestry programme in a city or a town.

HOW IS A CITY RECOGNIZED AS A TREE CITY?

To be recognized as a 'Tree City,' a city needs to meet five core standards that show its commitment to caring for its forests and trees. For a city to be recognized as a Tree City, it must delegate responsibility for the caring of trees within the municipal boundary to a city department, a staff member, or a group of citizens known as a Tree Board. Also, a law or an official policy must be in place in the city to govern the management of trees and forests. The city must also have an updated assessment or inventory of the local tree resources so that it can establish an effective long-term plan for caring for, planting, and removing city trees. The city must also have a dedicated annual budget for implementing a tree management plan. Also, the city must organise an annual celebration of trees with the aim of raising awareness among the people and must also acknowledge the citizens who have carried out the tree programme in the city.



HELINA: ANTI-TANK GUIDED MISSILE

- India has successfully flight-tested Helina, an Anti-Tank Guided Missile (ATGM), in Pokhran. According to the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO), it is one of the most advanced Anti-Tank Weapons in the world.
- The test was part of user validation trials of the third generation 'fire and forget'



class missiles developed by the DRDO.

WHAT IS HELINA?

Helina has been developed by the Defence Research and Development Laboratory (DRDL), Hyderabad under the Missiles and Strategic Systems (MSS) cluster of the DRDO.

NEPTUNE: ANTI-SHIP CRUISE MISSILE

Recently, Ukraine claimed that it has damaged the Russian Black Sea Fleet Flagship 'Moskva' by Neptune Anti-Ship Cruise Missiles.

WHAT IS NEPTUNE?

- The Neptune is a coastal anti-ship cruise missile that is capable of the destruction of naval vessels in a range of 300 km. The Missile system was inducted into the Ukrainian Defence Forces in March 2021 after being in development for six years.
- The cruise missile was developed in haste by the military as the Russian threat to the coastal areas of Ukraine was growing rapidly since the occupation of Crimea in 2014.
- The design of this missile is based on a Russian Kh-35 cruise missile which goes by the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) name of AS-20 Kayak. The cruise missile attack was carried out using TB-2

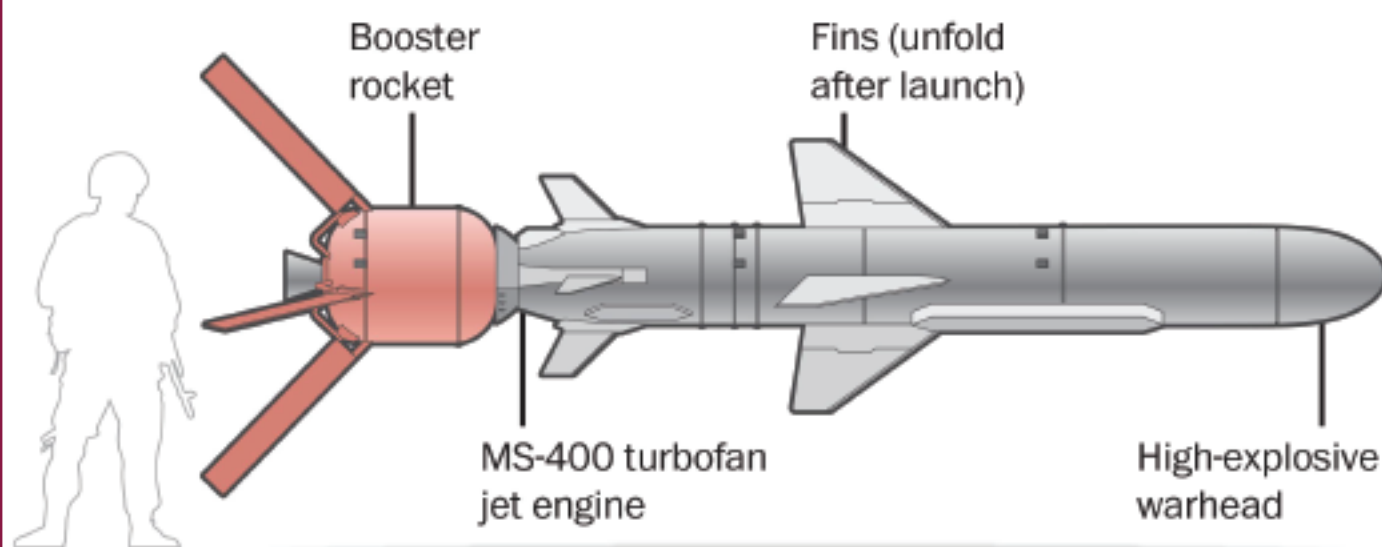
drones as decoys along with other measures toward saturation of the cruiser's Air Defence systems.

WHAT IS MOSKVA?

- Moskva is a guided missile cruiser of the Russian Navy named after the city of Moscow.
- A cruiser is a large surface warship built for high speed and great cruising radius, capable of not only defending its own fleet and coastlines but also threatening those of the enemy.
- The Moskva was originally commissioned as the Slava in 1983.
- It was recommissioned in 2000 as the Moskva with refurbished weapon systems and electronics. It has a displacement of 12,490 tons. It is the flagship of the Black Sea Fleet of the Russian Navy and carries a crew of around 500 personnel.

Ukraine's Neptune missile

The truck-launched RK-360 anti-ship cruise missile gives Ukraine a flexible, powerful punch against Russia's fleet.

PM Modi Released Commemorative Coin & Postage Stamp on 400th Birth Anniversary 9th Sikh Guru Tegh Bahadur

- On 21st April 2022, Prime Minister (PM) Narendra Modi released a commemorative coin and postage stamp to mark the 400th birth anniversary of 9th Sikh Guru Tegh Bahadur.
- He also addressed the nation on the occasion of the 400th Parkash Purab celebrations at Red Fort, Delhi and remembered the sacrifice of Guru “Guru Tegh Bahadur” who stood against Aurangzeb’s tyranny to protect the dignity of their culture.
- Guru Tegh Bahadur – popularly known as ‘Hind di Chaddar’, Jagat Guru. He was the ninth of the 10 Gurus of Sikh religion.
- The programme shall be organized by the Ministry of Culture in collaboration with the Delhi Sikh Gurdwar Management Committee (DSGMC).

Giriraj Singh launches 90-day campaign ‘Azadi Se Antyodaya Tak’

- Giriraj Singh, Union Minister for Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD) and Ministry of Panchayati Raj (MoPR), launched ‘Azadi Se Antyodaya Tak’, a 90-day campaign with a mission to saturate 75 Districts across 28 States and Union Territories (UTs) with 17 select beneficiary schemes of 9 Central Ministries.
- Celebrating India@75 Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav (AKAM), the identified 75 districts are aligned with the birthplace of 99 Unsung Freedom Fighters, who made the Ultimate Sacrifice for the nation during India’s Freedom Struggle.

PM Modi Launched India’s First Dairy Community Radio ‘Dudh Vani’

- Prime Minister (PM) Narendra Modi inaugurated India’s first Community Radio Station (CRS), ‘Dudh Vani’, dedicated to animal husbandry, during his three-day visit to Gujarat from April 18– 20, 2022.
- It is established by the Banaskantha District Cooperative Milk Producers’ Union Ltd (Banas Dairy), Palanpur, Gujarat.
- The establishment of Banas Dairy Community Radio Station (Dudh Vani – 90.4 FM) is the first such initiative for dairy farmers in India, which is the world’s largest milk producing country.

- The inauguration took place as part of the ongoing Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav celebrations and to commemorate Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar's 131st birth anniversary.
- Paytm has become an official digital payments partner for the prime ministers' museum.

- Stockholm Water Prize, established in 1991, is awarded by Stockholm International Water Institute (SIWI) in cooperation with the Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences.

India's 1st Community Museum Inaugurated in Gya-Sasoma villages, Leh, Ladakh

- Tashi Gyaltsen, Chairman/Chief Executive Councillor, Ladakh Autonomous Hill Development Council, LAHDC, Leh inaugurated the Community Museum in Gya - Sasoma villages of Leh district in Ladakh. This is a first of its kind museum in India and aims to preserve and take forward the rich cultural heritage of the region.
- It is a joint collaboration between National Museum Institute (NMI), New Delhi, Delhi and Ladakh Autonomous Hill Development Council (LAHDC), Leh, Ladakh.

O.Henry Prize

- Bengali writer Amar Mitra received the O.Henry Prize for Short Fiction 2022, the oldest major prize for short fiction in America. The English one was translated by Anish Gupta.
